### Summer 2010

**The 31st Annual** NC Quilt Symposium, "*Nothing Could be Finer than to be in Carolina*" was held on June 3-6, 2010 at Johnson and Wales University in uptown Charlotte, sponsored by NCQSI and the Charlotte Quilters' Guild. The Vendor Mall and Quilt Show were at the adjacent Greater Mount Moriah Primitive Baptist Church. The Thursday Evening program included the Opening Ceremony, Teachers' Show-and-Tell, a welcome reception and teacher book signing. Friday evening there was a Quilters Pajama Party and Fuzzy Slipper Fashion Show. The Saturday evening program was the first Iron Quilter competition. Contestants Robbi Jo Eklow, Karen Stone and their assistants were allowed 45 minutes to "cook up" a fabric appetizer, main dish and dessert. Attendees received an official chef hat and were treated to several surprises.
